### Introduction

The Government has provided additional funds to enable our school to better support those of our Sixth Form students whose learning has been significantly disrupted in 2020. The measure used to identify such students is where Grade 5 or above was not attained in English and/or maths. This statement details the programme adopted by Bournemouth School for Girls for the student(s) identified.

### Details of programme:

- Initial assessment of needs based on prior level attainment and identification of need.
- Personalised programme agreed with the Head of Sixth Form
- Additional 1 hour maths tuition support sessions, delivered on a 1-1 basis every fortnight by specialist maths teacher.
- Additional 30 minute tuition sessions in English and Maths, delivered on a 1-1 basis weekly by specialist teachers.
- Targeted mentor support on one to one basis.

The programme adopted is in addition to the student(s) A level programme of study, tutor contact and support, PHSE programme, and enrichment as provided within the 2020-21 academic year.

Bournemouth School for Girls confirm the funding provided by the 16-19 Tuition Fund Grant have been fully utilised within the above programme. Additional costs to meet this programme of support have been met by the school's resource allocation and other grant funds received.
